### g. HUDSON HOTEL

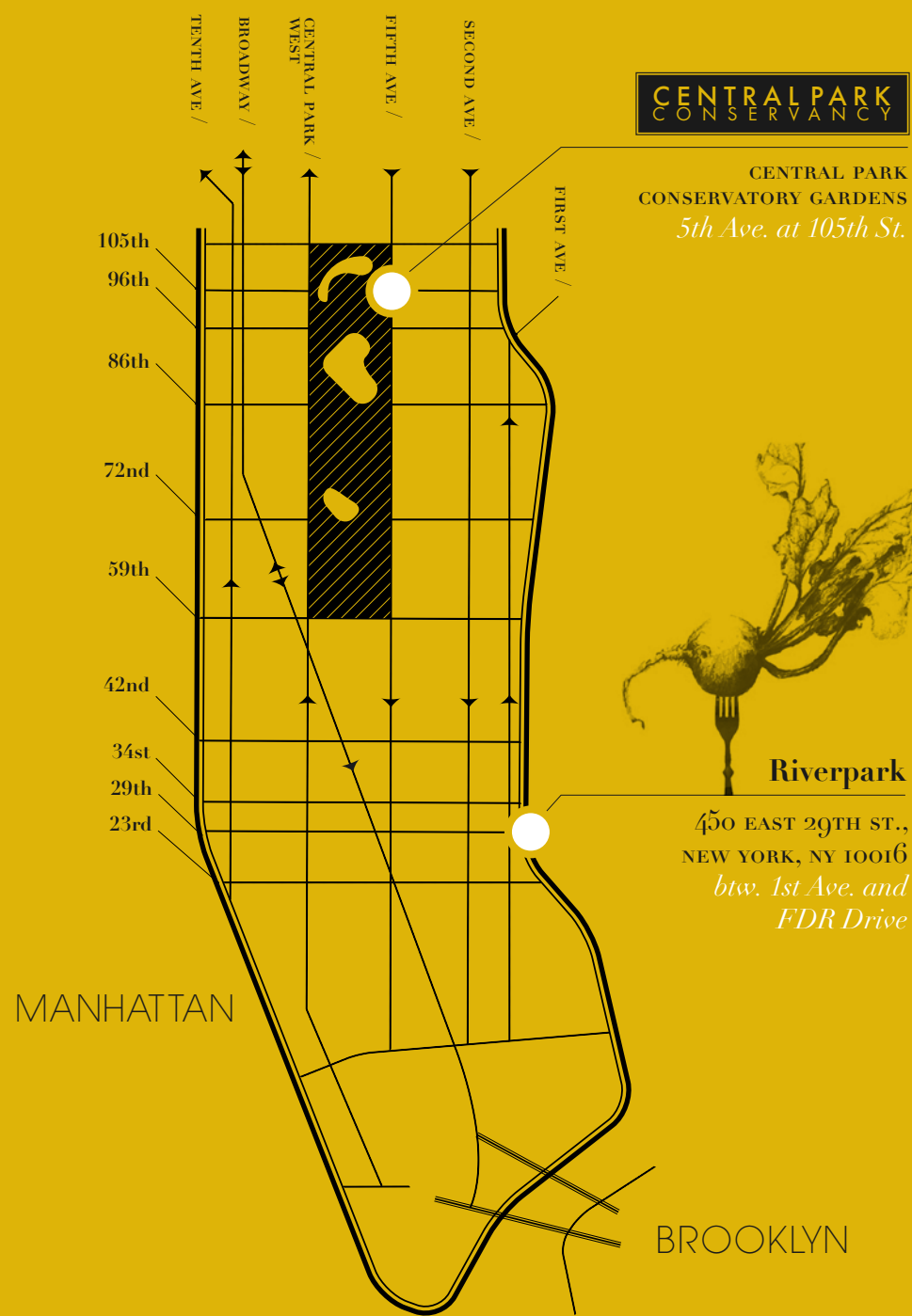

### DRIVING FROM NORTH OR LONG ISLAND

PARKING AVAILABLE AT A NUMBER OF AREA GARAGES:

- a. 12 East 105th St. Parking (105th St. btw Madison and 5th Ave.)
- b. East 105th St. Parking (btw 3rd and Lexington Aves.)
- c. 12-14 East 107th St. Parking (107th St. btw Madison and 5th Aves.)

### FROM PENN STATION

Catch a taxi at the taxi stand just outside the 8th Ave. exit, tell the driver to go to 5th Ave. at 105th St.

## { DIRECTIONS FROM CEREMONY TO RECEPTION }

### BY TAXI CAB

Catch a taxi on 5th Ave. If this is new to you be sure to ask one of our New Yorker guests for assistance!

### BY AUTOMOBILE

Drive South on 5th Ave. to 26th St. make a left. Take 26th St. East toward the River to 1st Ave. and make a left. Drive North on 1st Ave. to 29th St.. Riverpark is on the right at 29th St. and the East River.

### AND FOR THE ADVENTUROUS

Catch a pedicab ride (New York's answer to the rickshaw) through Central Park. Enjoy the magnificent views all the way to the southern entrance. Hop off there and catch a taxi further south to Riverpark. Be sure to have your photo taken first!
